Rural Development can provide loan guarantees to expand business operations; purchase and improve real estate; purchase machinery & equipment; refinance outstanding debt; and provide term working capital. The loan guarantee can be used to provide better rates and terms to the businesses you serve while reducing lender risk. In addition to reducing risk, the issuance of the loan guarantee can allow for additional fee income to be generated for the lender through the sale of the guaranteed portion on the secondary market.

We recently received a listing of priority projects from our headquarters in Washington DC. These priority projects are intended to further enhance the rural economies by providing well-paying employment, essential community services and long term investments. These priority projects include:

- Broadband; high-speed internet connectivity
- Commercially available unmanned technologies


